NOTIFICATION
Imphal, the 12th January, 2018

No.15/3/2015-Com&Ind 219. The Government of Manipur is satisfied that for the rapid industrialization of Manipur, it is necessary to exclude Boilers from certain provisions of the Boilers Act, 1923.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (3) of Section 34 of the Boilers Act, 1923 (No. 5 of 1923) and with the approval of the State Cabinet in its meeting on 04.01.2018 at 3 p.m., the Government of Manipur hereby excludes Boilers which have been installed or which will be installed in future in the State of Manipur from the operation of the provisions of Sections 7,8,9,10,12,13,14,15,16,17,19,20,20-A,21,22 and Section 23 subject to the following conditions, namely:-

- (6) Before the use of Boiler, the owner of the boiler may apply to the General Manager, District Industries Centre (hereafter referred to as DIC) of the concerned Districts along with the following documents to have the boiler registered-
 - (d) As per the provisions of clause (c) of Sub-Section (1) of Section 14 of the Boilers act, 1923, all necessary documents as provided in regulation 4 of the Indian Boilers Regulations 1950 along with applications for registration of the Boilers.
 - (e) A certificate from a "Boiler Engineer" with regard to the Boiler for the period and maximum pressure for which it can be safely used.

"Boiler Engineer" shall be a person who :

- (iii) is a Graduate in Mechanical or Production of Power Plant or Metallurgical Engineering from a recognized institution;
 - (iv) has a minimum of two years experience singly or cumulatively in the following fields related to Boilers:-
 - (VII) Design;
 - (VIII) Manufacture;
 - (IX) Commissioning;
 - (X) Operation and maintenance;
 - (XI) Inspection and certification during manufacture or operation and maintenance;
 - (XII) High Pressure Welding Inspection;
- Or is Lecturer / Reader / Professor in a recognized Engineering College.

- (f) Fees as prescribed in the Fee scheduled under the Boilers Act, 1923.
- (7) Thereafter, an Annual Certificate from "Boiler Engineer", as given below shall be submitted to the "DIC" with regard to that Boiler mentioning the pressure at which it can be safely used for a further period of 12 months.

- F. Registry number of Boiler/Economiser.
- G. Name, address, Telephone No. and e-mail address of boiler owner.
- H. Address where Boiler/Economiser installed.
- I. Name, address, Telephone No. And e-mail address of "Boiler Engineer" reporting fitness of Boiler/Economiser.
- J. Certificate of "Boiler Engineer"



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- (8) It will be responsibility of the owner of the Boiler to run and maintain it a provisions of the Boilers Act, 1923 and regulations and rules framed under the Act and owner shall also be responsible for any violation of the provisions or accident.
- (9) The "Boiler Engineer" shall follow the provision of the Boilers Act, 1923, rules and regulations framed there-under and shall be liable and responsible for any act or omission or commission committed against the provision of said Act, rules and regulations, including de-registration as "Boiler Engineer".
- (10) If the owner of boiler violates any provision of the Boilers Act, 1923, regulations and rules framed there under or any of the above provisions, in addition to penal provisions subsequent offence, besides penalty of Rs.5000, penalty of Rs.500/- per day shall be additionally imposed and/or restriction can be impose on the use of boiler. The General Manager, DIC shall be competent to impose the penalty or stop the use of the boiler. The owner may file an appeal with the Principal Secretary (Textiles, Commerce Industry) within 30 days of the order passed by the General Manager, DIC whose order should be final.


