Background (Status of availability of Infrastructure)	Gifted by the suitable agro-climatic conditions, Manipur is the home of many agro-horticultural produces like fruit & vegetables, spices, pulses, cereals, minor forest products, besides availability of fish, meat, poultry meat and traditional food products. Food Processing Industries consists of (i). Cereal/grain processing, (ii). Fruit & Vegetable processing, (iii). Meat & Poultry meat processing including egg, (iv). Milk and milk products, (v). Fish processing, (vi). Consumer foods.												
4.	Purpose and justification	The purpose of the project is the development of entrepreneurship, transfer of technology for processing of food products, to create facilities for training to produce skilled workers and building of capacity of entrepreneurs in food processing industries. Food Processing Industries Sector create a large employment generation in the urban, semi-urban, and rural areas. This sector is a priority sector in the country and State. The State Govt. has already established a Single Line Food Processing Training Centre at Porompat, Imphal East, Manipur. Because of the availability of land and present infrastructure, it is right time to establish Food Processing Training Institute at Imphal in view of the huge potentials for development of food processing industries in the State. The demand for such a institute is awaited for a long time and is the only institute in the State. The centre is proposed to upgrade into a Model Institution of Food Processing Industries as per decision taken in the meeting held on 21 <sup>st</sup> October, 2009 with Chief Secretary, Govt. of Manipur in the Chair.
