2. **Name of the scheme** :Promotion of Quality Assurance/Safety Concept.
3. **Objective:** To promote the concept of quality assurance and their adoption. To create awareness among the Food Processing Industries as well as consumers about the advantage of Safe and Quality foods through Generic advertisement, workshop/seminars etc. To train various stake holders engaged in food business and preparation of quality assurance training modules/guides/manuals, development of sector specific Codes of Practices such as GMP, GHP, GAP etc. from farm to fork and their implementation.

Good quality food products is the most essential of a food products. Therefore, general awareness among the food processing units as well as consumers about the advantage of Safe and Quality Foods through Generic advertisement, workshop, seminars, training, guides and specific codes of practices such as GMP, GHP, GAP etc. from farm to fork and their implementation are very important criteria. The Ministry of Food Processing Industries, Govt. of India, providing assistance for this scheme to the tune of 50% of the cost of the project subject to a maximum of Rs.3.00 lakh. The Directorate of Commerce & Industries, Manipur being the Nodal Agency, proposed to organize awareness-cum-training programme on Quality Assurance/Safety Concept in 3(three) districts of Manipur during the year 2006-07 out of 9(Nine) districts for the initial stage.
